Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the Anderson Building, Room 109, 445 E. Capitol Ave., Pierre, South Dakota, on August 1, 2016 at 9:00 a.m., to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules to the following:

Division of Motor Vehicles

64:30:02:01

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is that the Department of Revenue will be conducting the inspection and identification functions of the replacement and assigned vehicle identification number system.

The effect of the rule will be that the Department of Revenue will administer the replacement and assigned vehicle identification number system.

64:30:02:04

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify where applicants need to apply for assigned or replacement VINs and that the Department of Revenue will be scheduling and conducting any required inspections.

The effect of the rule will be that applicants will apply to their county treasurer for assigned or replacement vehicle identification numbers and that the Department of Revenue will schedule and conduct any required inspections.

64:30:02:04.01

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify where applicants need to apply for trailer identification numbers and that the Department of Revenue will inspect and attach the trailer identification number to any trailer weighing 3,000 pounds or more.

The effect of this rule will be clearer language, applicant's submitting their applications to the county treasurer of their county of residence, and that the Department of Revenue will conduct the inspections.

64:30:03:01

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to state that the secondary VIN location will now be obtained by the Department of Revenue from the National Insurance Crime Bureau.

The effect of this rule will be that the Department of Revenue will obtain information regarding the secondary VIN from the National Insurance Crime Bureau.

64:30:04:01

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify that the Department of Revenue is ordering, storing, and maintaining information regarding replacement and assigned VIN plates.

The effect of this rule will be that the Department of Revenue will order, store, and maintain information regarding replacement and assigned VIN plates.

64:30:04:02

The reason for adopting the proposed rule is to change the application requirements for an assigned or replacement VIN plate and how the mutilated or damaged VIN plate is removed from the vehicle and returned to the Department of Revenue.

The effect of the rule will be that the applicant will be required to submit a notarized statement regarding why an assigned or replacement VIN is being requested, require that the

applicant remove mutilated VINs still attached to the vehicle in the inspectors presence, and that the inspector will place the new VIN on the vehicle.

64:30:04:03

The reason for adopting the proposed rule is to clarify who is assigning the new VIN and attaching that VIN to the vehicle.

The effect of the rule will be that the Department of Revenue will assign new VINs and the inspector will affix the new VIN to the vehicle.

64:30:05:01

The reason for repealing this rule is that it will no longer be needed once ARSD 64:30:05:08 is amended.

The effect will be the repeal of this rule.

64:30:05:06

The reason for adopting the proposed rule is to clarify and make consistent the numbering system and application process for trailers.

The effect of this rule will be to clarify that homemade and rebuilt trailers weighing less than 3,000 pounds will receive a number from the county treasurer and trailers 3,000 pounds and over need to apply for a VIN.

64:30:05:07

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify that the Department of Revenue is the party assigning VINs to newly constructed vehicles.

The effect of this rule change is that the Department of Revenue continues to assign newly constructed vehicles with VINs.

64:30:05:08

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify that numbers will be affixed to all vehicles, including rebuilds, in the same manner.

The effect of this rule will be that VINs will continue to be affixed to vehicles other than motorcycles and trailers in the same manner.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Revenue – Legal Division, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-3185. Material sent by mail must reach the Department by August 16, 2016, to be considered.

After the hearing, the Department of Revenue will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Please notify the Department of Revenue at least 48 hours before the public hearing if you have special needs for which special arrangements must be made.
