South Dakota Department of Revenue to give audit presentation in Arlington

ARLINGTON, S.D. –The South Dakota Department of Revenue will discuss how businesses can prevent an audit during the Nov. 16 Arlington Chamber of Commerce meeting.

The segment of the monthly Chamber of Commerce meeting, which will be presented by the Department of Revenue’s Bridgette French, is tentatively scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. The monthly meeting takes place at Arlington City Hall, which is located at 202 W. Elm St.

French will cover a wide-range of topics including the audit selection process, what to do if you’re audited and common mistakes that can lead to an audit. The presentation will also give attendees helpful tips in record keeping and making payments.

Although taxes are not fun for many, they are a reality,” said French. “I hope that businesses that attend this seminar can obtain a higher confidence level in their reporting which can reduce the stress that an audit, or even meetings with the Department, can bring.”
